*These fields are required for registration: 3 (Dam ASA Reg #); 13 (Sire ASA Reg #); 14 (Tattoo); 15 (Tattoo Location); 16 (Sex); 18 (Birth Date); 19 (Multiple Birth Code); 32 (Horn/Polled/Scurred); and 33 (Color).

Dam Data

1. **DonorDamNbr**– Registration number assigned by ASA for Donor Dam of ET calf. *Required for all ET calves.*
2. **DonorDam Tatt**– Permanent identification for Donor Dam of ET calf.
3. ***BrthDamNbr** – Registration number assigned to the dam by ASA. *(For ET calf this will be RECIPIENT Dam)*
4. **BrthDamTatt** – Unique identification of dam. *Required if dam is not on file with ASA.*
5. **BrthDam BirthDt** – Birth date of the dam. *Required if dam is not on file with ASA.*
6. **BrthDam BrdCds** – Breed composition of the dam. *Required if dam is not on file with ASA.*
7. **Dam Prod** – Dam Productivity is used if there is no calf to report for the year.
8. **Prod Year** – Year reporting dam productivity for **Mature Cow Information** *(Assumed to be dam of calf being reported)*
9. **Dam Wt** – Mature weight of cow.
10. **Dam Wt Date** – Date mature cow measurements were taken.
11. **Dam HipHt** – Hip Height measurement (in) of mature cow.
12. **Cow BCS** – Body Condition Score of mature cow.

Calf Data

13. ***Sire ASA Reg #** – Registration number assigned to the sire by ASA. *If the sire is not registered with ASA, no matter the breed, then the calf can not be registered.*
14. ***AnmTatt** – Unique identification of calf. *It can be up to 9 characters and spaces and must contain the correct year letter designation.*
15. ***Tatt Loc** – Location of tattoo on body of calf.
16. ***Sex** – Sex of calf at birth and through weaning. *If a calf is castrated at weaning, report calf as a bull at birth and a steer at yearling. If a calf is castrated at birth, report calf as a steer at birth.*
17. **B Wt** – Birth Weight of the calf.

18. *Birth Date

- Date of birth of animal
19. ***MBC** (Multiple Birth Code) – Birth type of calf, such as a single, twin or ET calf. *For dams with more than one calf, please enter each calf separately.*
 20. **CE** (Calving Ease) – Amount of assistance given to dam during birth of calf.
 21. **AI Bred?** – Indicates if calf was product of artificial insemination or natural service.
 22. **HD** (Herd) – Use to designate contemporary groups at birth.
 23. **Calf Removal** – Use to report deceased calves.
 24. **Simbrah** – Indicates if calf is to be registered as a Simbrah.
 25. **Name** – Name of calf up to 24 characters and spaces. Refrain from using punctuation and symbols in name.
 26. **Reg** – (Register Calf) Indicates if calf is to be registered or only put on file with ASA. *If nothing is marked, calf will only be put on file.*
 27. **Cert** – (Certificate) Indicates if a certificate should be mailed. *If nothing is marked, certificate will be electronically filed.*

Weaning Information

28. **Weaning Wt** – Actual weight of calf taken at weaning and between 160–250 days of age. *ASA will adjust to 205 days.*
29. **Weaning Date** – Actual date weaning measurements were taken.
30. **MC** (Weaning Management Code) – Indicates diet of calf up to weaning. *Ex: dam only or creep feed.*
31. **PU** (Pasture Unit) – Use to designate different contemporary groups at weaning.
32. ***HPS** (Horned/Polled/Scurred) – Indicate status of calf.
33. ***Color** – Predominant color of calf
34. **Docility** – Record score of calf at weaning (see #41)
35. **Hip Height** – Hip Height measurement (in) at weaning.
36. **Sheath/Navel Score** – Condition of navel at weaning.

Yearling Information

37. **Yearling Wt** – Actual weight taken at yearling and between 330 – 440 days of age. *ASA will adjust to 365 days.*
38. **Yearling Date** – Actual date yearling measurements were taken.
39. **FU** (Yearling Feed Unit) – Use to designate different contemporary groups at yearling.
40. **Docility** – Record score of calf at yearling. **Note: If you wish to record a docility score without a weight, use the date column to list when the animal was observed.*
41. **Sex** – Sex of animal at yearling. *If bulls are castrated at weaning, report as a steer.*
42. **HipHt** – Hip Height measurement (in) as a yearling.
43. **ScrotalCirc** – Scrotal circumference measurement (cm) as a yearling bull.
44. **Pelvic Ht** – Height of pelvis as a yearling of heifers and bulls to the nearest ½ cm.
45. **Pelvic Width** – Width of pelvis as a yearling of heifers and bulls to the nearest ½ cm.

Transfer Information

46. **Buyer ASA #** – ASA membership number of buyer, if available.
47. **Buyer Name** – Name or Ranch of buyer that will print on certificate.
48. **Buyer Address, City, State, ZIP** – Street address of buyer, City, State and ZIP Code of buyer.
49. **Date of Sale** – Date on which animal was sold.
50. **Mail To:** – Indicate to whom the certificates should be mailed after transfer. *If left blank, certificates will be mailed to buyer.*

Breeding Data

51. **Breeding Data** – Indicate whether the cow was bred at the time of transfer. Include AI Sire Reg# and exposure date and/or Pasture Sire Reg# and exposure dates if bred.
